Commissioner Andolino to be Honored at the 2010 Boys Town of Chicago "Evening of Promise"

Chicago Department of Aviation Commissioner Rosemarie S. Andolino has been selected as the 2010 Honoree by Boys Town of Chicago.

The official announcement of Commissioner Andolino as the "Evening of Promise" 2010 Honoree will be made during a VIP Breakfast with Honorary Event Chairman Richard M. Daley and Boys Town of Chicago Executive Director Rev. Bruce Wellems. The Breakfast will be held on Thursday, September 2, 2010 at 8:00 a.m. at the Claretians Building, 205 W. Monroe in Chicago.

The 2010 Boys Town of Chicago "Evening of Promise" Reception will take place on Thursday, October 7, 2010 at Soldier Field. The reception will formally recognize and celebrate Commissioner Andolino as the 2010 Honoree. This fundraising event will support the Boys Town of Chicago's outreach services for at-risk children and families in the Back of the Yards/New City community.

Commissioner Andolino is currently a Board Member of Boys Town of Chicago and has been an active supporter and participant within the organization since 2005.

Boys Town of Chicago has been serving the residents of the Back of the Yards/New City community since opening the Casa Tepeyac home in 2007. Their services provide a safe environment where at-risk youth can participate in positive, skill-building activities, and also help the youths' families. In 2009, Boys Town's Integrated Continuum of Care touched the lives of 45,139 people in Illinois, including direct care to 190 children and 45 families. Father Bruce Wellems, pastor of Holy Cross-Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish, serves as the Executive Director.

The O'Hare Modernization Program (OMP), introduced by Mayor Richard M. Daley in June 2001, transforms O'Hare's airfield from an outdated system of intersecting runways into a modern parallel runway configuration. The program will reduce overall delays at the Airport by 79 percent, and bad weather delays by 95 percent. It will create 195,000 new jobs and \$18 billion in additional economic activity each year.
