

O'HARE NOISE COMPATIBILITY COMMISSION RESOLUTION 2007-4

WHEREAS, the O'Hare Noise Compatibility Commission (O'Hare Commission) is an intergovernmental entity whose responsibilities pursuant to the Intergovernmental Agreement Relating to the O'Hare Noise Compatibility Commission ("Intergovernmental Agreement") among the City of Chicago and various other municipalities and school districts include directing the further development of the noise compatibility program for the O'Hare Affected Area, establishing criteria for the allocation of Approved PFC's for Approved Projects in the O'Hare Affected Area (as those capitalized terms are defined in the Intergovernmental Agreement), and advising the City of Chicago concerning Chicago O'Hare International Airport related noise issues;

WHEREAS, in September 2005, the Federal Aviation Administration ("FAA") issued a Record of Decision ("ROD") regarding the O'Hare Modernization Program ("OMP"), whose implementation will alter the areas affected by aircraft noise, and consequently the particular dwellings impacted by such noise and potential eligibility to receive sound insulation;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Intergovernmental Agreement, and as referenced in O'Hare Commission Resolution 2006-3, the O'Hare Commission established criteria for the 2006 Program Year of the Residential Sound Insulation Program ("Program") at Chicago O'Hare International Airport ("O'Hare");

WHEREAS, the O'Hare Commission is now offering sound insulation to the eligible residences that the FAA has projected will be impacted by the implementation of the OMP, and as required by the ROD, in a process that will require several Program years;

WHEREAS, for the 2006 Program Year, there are several homes who previously had declined or were not eligible for earlier opportunities to participate in the Program. Those homes are now deemed potentially eligible for sound insulation under the O'Hare Modernization Program Full Buildout Noise Contour ("O'Hare Noise Contour") as ("Previous Residences");

WHEREAS, these Previous Residences deemed potentially eligible under the O'Hare Noise Contour include owner-occupied, rentals and multi-family dwellings, and are consistent with the Fairness Policy incorporated in O'Hare Commission Resolution 2006-3;

WHEREAS, the O'Hare Commission desires to provide the owners of the Previous Residences with an opportunity to participate in the Program by incorporating them into the "Regional Groupings";

WHEREAS, the O'Hare Commission wishes to identify the number of Previous Residences in all of the communities that are still within the O'Hare Noise Contour;

WHEREAS, for purposes of Program administration, the O'Hare Commission wishes to include individual Previous Residences in the Regional Grouping located nearest to the Previous Residence, and that the owners of Previous Residences be extended an invitation to participate in the Program along with homeowners in the nearest community's Regional Grouping;

NOW THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the O'Hare Commission that:

Section 1. The above recitals are incorporated in this resolution by this reference.

Section 2. Subject to available funding, the 2006 Program Year should offer sound insulation to Previous Residences consistent with the Fairness Policy established in O'Hare Commission Resolution 2006-3.
